KALBFUS ROD AND GUN CLUB TRAP AND SPORTING CLAYS LEAGUES

KALBFUS ROD AND GUN CLUB ANNUAL JUNIOR PHEASANT HUNT

The Pennsylvania Game Commission provides two pheasants for each hunter. We're fortunate to have volunteers that bring their field dogs to the hunt for our hunters. There will be a morning hunt starting at 9:00 after which Kalbfus will provide a lunch for everyone attending. Anyone is welcome to come to the hunt and observe.

BENEFIT SPORTING CLAYS SHOOT

Cornplanter Chapter #526, Trout Unlimited will be hosting a benefit 3-Bird Sporting Clays Shoot October 13, at Kalbfus starting at 9:00. Semi-automatic and pump action shotguns with plugs removed are recommended for a 3-Bird Shoot. Shooters can take multiple shots at all targets until either the target is broken or it hits the ground. Rules and guidelines for a 3-Bird shoot will be available at the shoot. Bring plenty of ammunition!

LONG RANGE, 200 AND 300 YARD, SHOOTING AT KALBFUS

We will no longer offer long range, 200 or 300 yard, shooting at Kalbfus. We had planned to offer long range shooting but realized that our fields of fire for both ranges presented a significant safety hazard for foot and vehicular traffic. Goosheven on Egypt Hollow Road has a facility specifically dedicated to long range shooting out to 500 yards.

SIGHT-IN DAYS AND GUN RAFFLE

New Regular Full membership-\$35.00 including \$5.00 initiation fee

New Senior (65+) Full membership-\$25.00 including \$5.00 initiation fee

Renewal Regular Full membership-\$35.00 or \$30.00 if paid in full by February 28, of the new year

Renewal Senior Full membership-\$25.00 or \$20.00 if paid in full by February 28, of the new year

Delinquent Regular fees-(no discounts) \$35.00 for each delinquent year plus \$35.00 for the current year

Delinquent Senior fees-(no discounts) \$25.00 for each delinquent year plus \$25.00 for the current year
